Are you frustrated by the lack of action to make cycling safer ?

Do you want safe space for cycling on busy roads and at major junctions ?

Safe and enjoyable travel by bike needs **#space4cycling** so more people can cycle more often.

We're calling for dedicated **space for cycling** on main roads; and on smaller roads we're calling for the removal of through motor traffic and the reduction of motor vehicle speeds.

Ride with us from 6.30pm on Monday 30th September to show your support!

It's not a party political event, we'll deliver copies of the same petition to the Conservative party, Manchester City Council and Transport for Greater Manchester. And it's not a protest; we want this mass ride to be a fun, family friendly event where we cycle together to raise awareness of the issue.

Assemble in St Peter's Square M2 3DE from 6pm, the ride will set off at 6.30pm. There will be plenty of space as Mosley St is closed to motor vehicles during the conference.

We need space for cycling so more people, of all ages and abilities, can feel safe enough to ride a bike for more of our everyday journeys.
