We're also calling for a well-funded cycling and walking investment strategy and for the Secretary of State for Transport to pledge to support the ECF's EU roadmap for cycling.

We need space for cycling so more people, of all ages and abilities, feel that it's safe enough to ride a bike for everyday local journeys.
